



# Red Rock Canyon Open Space (West Side Route)



## Hike Information

**Rating: 4 - Easy/Moderate**

**Distance: 3.9 Miles**

**Total Elevation Gain\*: 453 feet**

**Starting Elevation: 6,191 feet**

**Hike Time: ~2.0 Hours**

**Total Event Time\*\*: ~2.0 to 2.5 Hours**

**Dog Friendly: Yes (on leash)**

*\* Total Elevation Gain includes total feet climbed throughout hike and does not represent difference between low and high points.*

*\*\* Total Event Time includes Hike Time plus transportation to and from the initial meeting point.*

## Hike Description

This is a 3.9-mile loop hike which offers fabulous views and even several interesting features within Red Rock Open Space near Manitou Springs.

Hikers begin at the eastern parking lot and walk up the Red Rock Canyon Path past the ponds and then toward the main quarry. From here, the route traverses over the Quarry Pass Trail (a pretty fun little scramble), working up to the Mesa Trail, and then winding back down the Roundup Trail and finally a relaxing walk back down the main canyon.

One of the interesting benefits of this location is the varied outdoor activities, including mountain-biking and rock climbing. At the start and end of the walk, hikers typically see multiple rock-climbing groups along the main canyon, some which are taking on very difficult routes along the canyon walls.

This hike consists of dirt and rock, sometimes involving stepping up and around obstacles in the rougher places of the trail. The views are excellent along the entire route, including Garden of the Gods, an overlook of downtown Colorado Springs, and splendid views of the surrounding front range mountains.

This location includes a wide variety of trees and plants, including ponderosa pines, Douglas fir, Rocky Mountain juniper, cottonwood, aspen, and even yucca. Visitors commonly find mule deer, coyotes, as well as hawks and songbirds. Although rare, foxes, black bears, and mountain lions can also be spotted here, so hikers are encouraged to remain with the group.

This is a fantastic hike which can be done by hikers of nearly all ability-levels. With ample parking and numerous interesting features, this hike is sure to provide a memorable adventure!

## What To Bring

Water:  = 40 ounces

Food: Light, Healthy Snack

Clothing: Breathable Layers (adjust for daily temps)

Footwear: Comfortable hiking boots or shoes

Headgear: Hat

Safety: Sunscreen, Sunglasses

Optional: Hiking Poles

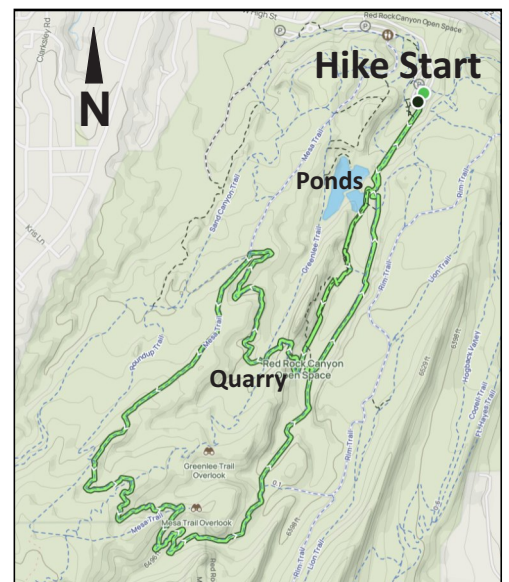
**Buffalo Lodge** can be a little tricky to navigate the first time you visit. This is a 5-acre self-enclosed lodge with numerous buildings. As you first pull into the property, you will see the main Lodge Office on the right...**this is where the group meets for the hike.**

However, please do not park up front as this is only for lodging guests. Instead, drive through the lot to the rear area and park in the large dirt lot marked "Event Parking". You will then walk to the front of the lot and meet us at the main Lodge Office.

Mountain Trails members may choose to ride with someone, offer a ride to other hikers, or simply follow the caravan in their own vehicle. The priority for this hike series are the Buffalo Lodge guests; if any guest needs a ride, we will provide them with transportation.

Regardless where you choose to meet the group (Buffalo Lodge or hike meeting point), hiking club members are encouraged to visit Buffalo Lodge as they have a lounge with interesting decor, a variety of activities, a bicycle shop, and live music most nights of the week.
